Literacy level of your population	Multiple choice answers are sufficient. Written comments are asked for only at the end to illicit concerns. Would you like help discussing developmental milestones with parents or gauging parental concerns? In other words, how responsive do you expect parents to be (based on education, language, etc.)?	Six questions for each area of development - Easy numerical scoring that is compared to standardized cutoff scores.	One question addressing concern in each area of development - Scoring is based on number of concerns parent has and whether that is a 'predictive concern' or not, leading to one of five responses (refer, reassurance, promote development, counsel, refer or do a secondary screen.)	Focus is on Social-Emotional Development. Could be used at specific ages to discuss behavior and mental health issues.	One question for each area of development with 'failure' answers recommending referral in that area.
